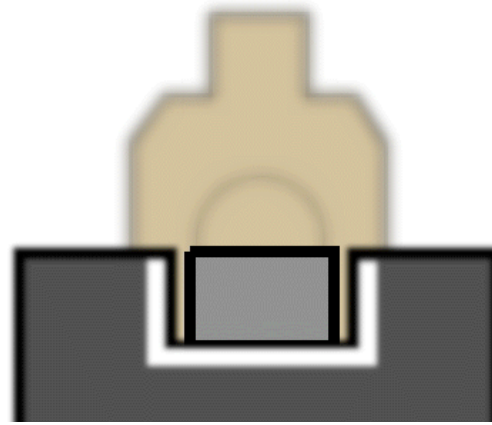

Arizona CCW Permit Training

The ARIZONA CONCEALED WEAPONS PERMIT course is a firearms safety course designed to provide a general introduction to firearms and pistol shooting. The course curriculum includes:

- Four Rules of Firearms Safety
- Safe Storage and Handling of Firearms
- Where you can and cannot legally carry a concealed firearm
- Arizona law relating to the use of physical and lethal force.
- When you are justified in using force to defend yourself or your family
- Introduction to the Combat Triad of Mindset, Marksmanship and Gun Handling Skills
- Using Levels of Awareness to avoid becoming a victim of violent crime.
- How to load, unload and clear most common pistol malfunctions.
- Legal ramifications of using Lethal Force
- Shoot / No Shoot Scenarios involving firearms
